- Who:** Golf course and club operations in the U.S. Western Region
- When:** Beginning each spring for placements 3-12 months long (depending on your needs and interests)
- What:** You provide a quality work and training experience for an international green keeping student or professional. In exchange you get a unique cross cultural experience, an exchange of ideas, and establish new professional contacts. Wages for your intern or trainee are provided by you and vary for each host, but must meet fair labor standards. We encourage you to fill out a host application and view applicant profiles at no cost. Host fees associated with the program are not collected until your visitor arrives.

Experience International staff will work closely with you to ensure a positive and productive experience. Support includes:

- Screening and selection of participants
- Assistance in developing training plans
- J-1 visa sponsorship
- Travel logistics and arrival orientation
- Host and Intern Manuals
- Support with medical issues and tax information
- Streamlined reporting for you and your intern to meet federal regulations
