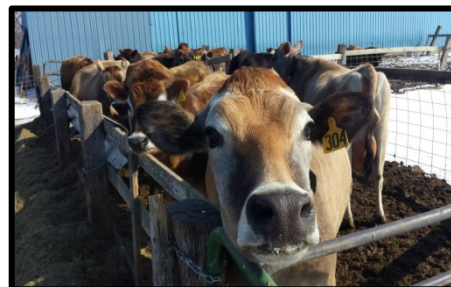

and Minnesota



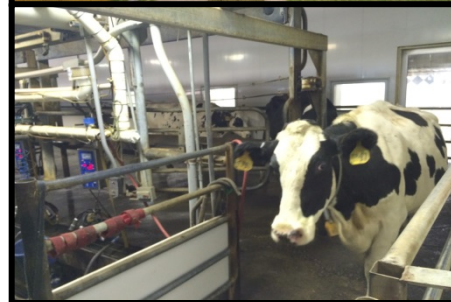
## When:
