Placements Include:

- Large- and small-scale field crops, dairy, beef, sheep, horticulture, ag mechanics, apiary
- Dairy placements available year-round, for 6-12 months
- Best time for cropping is March-May or harvest is September-December
- A 7-month placement for cropping is perfect so that trainees can do both seeding and cropping and have a holiday between
- Horticulture is best for 10-12 months

Wage

- Wages are at least \$23.23 per hour (~\$14.82 USD), and overtime is paid after a 38-hour week
- You earn approx. \$692 AUD per week after tax and accommodation

Program Fee

- Inbound Fee: AUD \$1250 (~\$800 USD)
- Experience International Fee: \$600 USD
- Visa Fee: AUD \$644 (~\$410 USD)
- Insurance: AUD \$864 - approx. maximum for 12 months (\$590 USD)

Accommodation

- All hosts provide housing and may deduct rent costs
- Most trainees need to supply their own meals, although there is usually some help during busy periods in a cropping placement (e.g. seeding/harvest)

Requirements

- At least one year hands-on agriculture experience or current student in agricultural school
- Experience with machinery and in the field for which you are applying
- Family farm background OR formal agricultural education

Process

- Submit your CV, autobiography and placement requests to Experience International to get the application started. We will help you complete the IRE application!
- Once the application with all supporting documents is received, it takes approximately 4-10 weeks to get a placement and an additional 8 weeks to receive your visa.
