Placements Include:

- Large crop: wheat, soy, canola, durham, flax, barley, lentils, oats. Placement April-Nov or Aug-Nov
- Beef or Dairy: 3-12 months, flexible start
- Mixed Livestock & Crops: mainly beef, some dairy, sheep and bison. Flexible start and duration
- Very limited placement options: cheese factory, equine, sheep, goat, poultry, leafcutter bee, organic, and agri-home placements. Flexible start and duration

Wage

- Salary of \$1,700-\$2,000 CAD per month (~\$1,300-\$1,500 USD), based on a 45-hour work week with 1.5 days off per week. Three weeks of unpaid holidays for full-season participants
- Hosts may take a deduction of \$450 for housing and meals each month
- Additional deductions are income tax, Canadian Pension Plan, and Employment Insurance
- Sometimes trainees are able to get a refund of their income tax, depending on their country's tax treaty with Canada

Program Fee

- IRE Inbound Fee: \$787 CAD for 3-4 months and \$945 CAD for 5-12 months
- Experience International Fee: \$600 USD
- Visa Fee: \$155 CAD
- Biometrics Fee: \$85 CAD
- Insurance: \$60 USD per month plus \$50 admin fee, purchased through IRE

Accommodation

- Housing and meals provided on site and you are generally treated like members of the farm family
- Usually there is a wage deduction for housing

Requirements

- Minimum one year of practical, related experience, including machinery
- Driver's license
- Open to ages 18-35
- Complete biometrics in person at an approved office in your area

Process

- Once your full application is received, it takes approximately 2 months to get a placement and an additional 2 months to be issued the work permit
