Placements Include:

- Mixed farms (beef, swine, dairy and/or field crops with ag machinery)
- Limited Organic Vegetables, Viticulture/Enology, Nurseries/Horticulture, and Orchards
- Placements are on family farms working side by side with farmers
- Ideal start between March and October

Duration

- 3-12 months
- Current students can stay a maximum of 12 months
- Placements for graduates are harder to find and usually require good practical experience
- Year-round openings for livestock, June-October best for crops

Wage

- Students: 400 EUR (~\$440 USD) per month; board and lodging provided for free
- Graduates: approx. 12 EUR/hour; pre-tax (minus room and food costs)
- 40 hours work per week. If more hours, will be paid accordingly or given comp time. Two days holiday per month of work.

Program Fee

- DBV Inbound Fee: 250 EUR for students, 350 EUR for graduates
- Experience International Fee: \$600 USD
- Visa Fee: 75 EUR
- Insurance: \$70+ USD per month purchased through Experience International

Accommodation

- For students: room and board provided with farm family at no cost
- Graduates must pay up to 265 EUR for accommodation and 288 EUR for food per month

Requirements

- Some hands-on, related experience (minimum 6 months)
- Must have a valid Driver's License and be at least 18 years old
- Speaking German is helpful and must be willing to learn in-country

Process

- Apply 4 months ahead of start date.
- You will need complete application, submit references, and interview
- You will be invited to take part in a one-week international seminar in July
