Application Process

- Submit Resume and Placement Request (tell us more about what you want and when)
- Discuss options with Experience International
- Experience International distributes your request to Exchange partner abroad
- Complete application and supporting materials for the Exchange partner organization selected
- Placement offered based on your experience, major, dates, & length of placement requested
- Placement information provided to applicant prior to accepting placement

Services Provided by Experience International

- Quality placements through established exchange partners abroad
- Help with applications & documents necessary for visa and/or work permit
- Information about cultural adjustment and what to expect
- 24/7 support in the event of an emergency and/or difficulties encountered abroad

Finances

- Participants receive wages or a combination of food and housing
- Experience International Program Fee: \$600 (\$100 deposit, \$500 once placed)
- Partner Organization Program Fee varies by country and ranges from approx. \$400-\$1,100
- Participants are responsible for airfare and some expenses abroad
- Health and travel insurance may be purchased with EI's assistance
- Scholarships offered by your college may reduce your expenses substantially

Qualification Criteria

- **Age:** 19 years or older
- **Experience:** Documented hands-on work experience in field related to requested placement (some countries require one year of experience)
- **Education:** Enrolled student or graduate of a post-secondary agricultural program usually required
- **Health:** No physical or mental health conditions that would limit activities or safety
- **Language:** Germany - some German preferred. Spain - Spanish classes may be required after arrival. Other countries require only English. A willingness to learn the local language while abroad is expected.
