Placements Include:

- Dairy: 3-12 months, placements available all year - best start in July.
- Arable Farming (Sept -May); harvesting, cultivation, and stock work (5-7 months, starting in Jan - end of March)
- Horticulture (4-12 months, starting in August-October)
- Enology/Wine (3-12 months, starting in February)
- Vineyard Harvest Machine Operators (6 months, starting in Sept - Oct)

Wage

- Start at \$23.50 NZD per hour (approx.\$14) before taxes and housing
- Housing costs are usually deducted weekly

Program Fees

- Rural Exchange Inbound Fee: \$1050 NZD (~\$650)
- Experience International Fee: \$750
- NZ Visa Fee: \$1355 NZD (~\$820) - *Scholarships available!*
- Medical Health Insurance: approximately \$80+ per month

Accommodation

- Most hosts provide housing and will deduct weekly lodging fee for accommodation
- Housing may be on site, with host family, shared, or in a hostel
- Most trainees need to supply their own meals

Requirements

- Student or graduate of agriculture program
- One year experience in the field for which you are applying
- Have a valid international driver's license

Process

- Once your application is received, allow approximately 12 weeks to get a placement and visa
- You will not have to visit an Embassy
